

# Chapter 13

## Wills and Letters of Administration.

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### Wills, Admons and Inventories

This section contains three main types of record:

1. **Wills** - a will can be made by anybody and you do not have to be a wealthy individual to make one. It is a written document which lays down exactly what the person who is making the will, wishes to be done with his or her possessions after their death. Whoever makes a will is known as a testator. The testator will normally appoint executors, who would probably be friends or relatives, to take the responsibility of ensuring that their wishes are carried out. After the death of the testator, probate is obtained from the relevant authorities. When the will is thus proved, the executors are legally empowered, after payment of death or other duties, to distribute the testators assets and possessions in accordance with the testator's instructions. Wills can provide a wealth of information to the family historian about the life style of an ancestor.
2. **Admons** - admons (or letters of administration) are grants that are made to the next of kin of the deceased who died without making a will. The term is known as 'dying intestate'. The information contained within these documents are not normally of any great interest to the family historian, although they can sometimes yield valuable clues. An admon gives an individual the right to wind up the affairs of or administer the property of the deceased.

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3. **Inventories** - are lists of the personal and household goods left by the deceased and accompany many earlier wills.

## Where to find Wills, Admons and Inventories

This is a difficult question to answer simply and there are specialist books available to the serious researcher, which answer the question very fully. In short, wills can be found all over the country. The following is a general guide to assist you:

### Wills dating before 1858

These can be broadly found in three types of repositories:

1. The ordinary citizen would have his or her proven in the Court of the archdeaconry in which the testator died. In the case of the Jephcotts, most of the wills are to be found in the Diocesan Record Office at Lichfield, which covers the Coventry area.
2. Where the testator was a wealthy individual or had pretensions of status, his or her will might be proven in the PCC (Prerogative Court of Canterbury), the records of which can be seen at the PRO, London, or in the PCY (Prerogative Court of York), the records of which are held in York.
3. Between the years 1655 to 1660 all wills were proved by PCC and are held at the PRO, London.

### Wills dating after 1857

These wills are held at the Public Record Office, London.

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## Further Notes

The indexes, transcript extracts and transcripts on the following pages have been compiled from the many sources of wills that I and my fellow researchers have come across. If you know of any that I have missed, I would be pleased to receive the details.

I have obtained copies of and have transcribed most of the wills up to 1858. However, due to the very lengthy task of printing all of this data in this book, not to mention the large number of pages it would take up, I have only included transcription extracts for wills up to around 1650. Extracts for the remaining wills may well become the subject of a later publication. In the meantime, if any individual would like further details of a particular will, I would be pleased to assist, where possible.

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## CALENDER OF WILLS AT LICHFIELD JOINT RECORD OFFICE

The following index has been compiled from a search of the calendar of wills that was found at Lichfield Joint Record Office, Fish Street, Lichfield. The peculiarities of the diocese system has meant that most wills made by our Jephcott ancestors prior to 1858, are to be found at Lichfield.

Most of these wills have been copied for our records and many of them also include inventories. A number has been given to each item to assist you with finding a transcript later in this section.

In the name of God Amen the first day of July in the five and twentieth yeare of the reigne of our sovereigne Lord Charles the second by the Grace of God King of England, Scotland, France and Ireland defender of the faith - I Jonathan Jephcot of Ouseden in the County of Suffolke clerke haveing my mortality before mine eyes doe make and appoint this my last Will & Testement in manner here followinge ffirst I commend my soule when it shall leave my body into the hands of almighty God from whom I hope to receive full pardon of all my sinnes and the blessing of eternall life through the onely meritt of the Lord Jesus Christe and my body to the ground to be buried in honest and decent Xiam Buriall and all my wordly goods I and bequeath in manner following/imprimis I give and bequeath unto my sonne Barjonah my gold ring.

My watch and all my bookes/item I give unto him twenty pounds in the hands of Thomas Condall of Great Thurlowe in the county of Suffolke and twenty pounds in the hands of Mr Henry Parshby of Swaffham prior in the county of Cambridge/Item I give unto him my said sonne ffoure pounds in lieu of a sute of apparrell which I promised his master to give him/item I give unto my daughter Elizabeth Kent one and ffiftie pounds out of the moneys which are in the hands of Roger Pant Esq of Swaffham prior in Cambridgeshire/item I give unto my daughter Anne Ffourescore and one pounds the remainder of the principall of one hundred thrity two pounds in the hands of the said Roger Pant all the rest of my moneys goods cattell , chattells not before bequeathed after all funerall charges and other and other charges for proveing my will discharged I give them equally to be divided between my three children before named and I make constitute and appoint my beloved sonne Barjonah executor of this my last will and teatment and in case any question or controversie should arise about the parting of my goods I doe appoint my loveing friende Mr Thomas Roper and Edward Thomas Clerke to divide the same equally as I have devised and to sett forth to each childe his part my meaninge is that all arreares of rent and interest of money that shall be due at my death shall be attomited into the sume of my goods to be devided only the interest of Thomas Condalls twenty pounds excepted and because my daughter Elizabeth Hath onely a state for life in three halfe acres of Arrable cquihold land in Swaffham prior my will is that my sonne Barjonah sall at her request and charge remedy the reversion which he will have in the same to her and her heires and I doe hereby revoke all former wills by me heretofore made in witesse whereof to this my last will and teatment I have sett myne hand and seale the day and yeare first above written by me Jonathan Jephcot read acknowledged subscribed and sealed in the presence of tho Roper Lucy Moseley

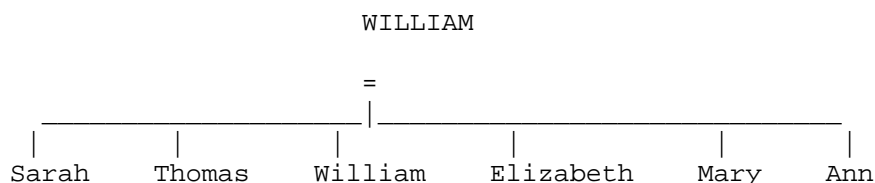

Will of John Jephcott of Ansty dated 1561

The following is a transcript of the will of John Jephcott which was written shortly before his death in 1561. From the details given and with the aid of other wills and the Ansty parish registers, it has been possible to trace several subsequent generations. Also included with the will was the customary inventory of his possessions.

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In the name of god Amen; The therd daye of the moneth of aprell: In the yere of our lorde god A thousand fyve hundreth thre score and one. \* in ye thred yere of the Reygne of our soverent ladye Elyzabeth by ye grace of god of england. frnce. irelande. quene I jhan Jephcott of the perreshe of anstie husbande man beyng in sound And perfit memorie I prayse and thanke god therfore. devise & ordayne this my present testamente contaynyng my last wyll & testamente in maner & forme folowing fyrst I bequeth my sole to almighty god & amonge ye blessed companye of heaven. and my bodye to be beryed in the Churcheyard of ansste. Itm I bequethe unto siex of my chyldren. as Nycolas. Jhan. Wyllyam. Thomas Katherin \* margarit. to everye one of them four j markes. & the boyes to have his delyvered to them when ye com to xx yerres of ther age & the whenches to have it delyvered to them at ther daye of maryage or els at xxj yerres of ther age & yf it chans that anye of my chyldren do depart this lyfe before the come to the yerres above wrytten my wyll is that ye other ye remayne alyve shall have ye parte or partes equallye devydid amonst them and yf the all decease then ye longest lyver to have all. Itm Nycolas shall have ye folden tabell ye gt pan & ye ---- that his grandfather gave him & if he lyve to thte yere weytten. yf not the to remeayne to Harrye his brother and yf he dye in lyke maner the to remeyne to Jhan and yf he depart this lyfe before he com to the yerres above wrytten the to remeyne to William & if hy dye yn to Thomas his brother yf he be then lyvyng.
